Stewardship week is the last Sunday in April until the first Sunday in May. We have sent out activity sheets, posters and book marks to all schools in the area.

Conservation Days is all lined out and ready to go next week. We will have Forsyth and Hysham schools on Tuesday May 6th, Lane deer & Ashland Schools on Wednesday May 7th at Crazy Head Springs, and on Thursday we will have Colstrip Schools at the Surge Pond. We will be using Colstrip Surge Pond as an alternative site for the Forsyth Hysham day in the event of rain or problems accessing the original sites.

Trees are being shipped this week and will be delivered on Thursday and Friday. Producers have been contacted and will be picking them up at that time. This year we have sold approximately 7500 trees.
