The Rosebud County Soil Conservation District Supervisors met in the District office with the following members present:

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman.

Minutes of the preceding meeting were read and approved.

Art Pooch reported on the financial condition of the district, showing a balance of \$1056.51. There is one outstanding receipt from Fred Boyd.

Erle Gross gave notice of the Billings Workshop. Ray Grossman stated he would take his car, and Ivan Dahlman, R. J. Borer and Erle Gross stated that they would attend.

Ray Grossman discussed purpose of increased appropriation from the State and urged the Supervisors to discuss same with legislators and interested people.

Seeding roadsides was discussed and R. J. Borer moved that the District urge the State Highway Commission to plant grass to roadsides. Motion seconded and carried. It was also suggested that a carbon copy of the letter to the State Highway Commission be sent to Sivert Mysee, Jr. and R. C. Harken.

The Chairman appointed Everett Redeen and R. J. Borer to meet with the County Commissioners and discuss seeding roadways.

Erle Gross, County Agent, urged education and promotion of leveling spoil banks on ditches.

The Secretary was instructed to invite Board members of the Yellowstone Irrigation District to the next meeting for the purpose of discussing leveling of spoil banks, reseeding and sealing of ditches.

A discussion was held regarding payment of district fees by contractors. The Board suggested that Grossman contact F. R. Hardesty & Son and discuss the agreement which contractors sign with the district.

Ray Grossman was instructed to get more information on ASC assignments.

A discussion was held regarding the Conservation Caravan.

Grossman passed out Land and Water Bulletins.

There appearing no further business to come before the Board at this time the meeting adjourned.

HELD NOVEMBER 9, 1956

The Board of Supervisors of the Rosebud County Soil Conservation District met on November 9th, at the District Office.

The meeting was called to order by the chairman, Don Luhman.

Minutes of September 12th and the unofficial meeting of October 12th were read and approved.

Art Pooch gave a summary of the business since the last financial report, and the present financial condition of the district.

The Group discussed assigning of ASC payment direct to the district for all work done, rather than having the operator repay the district its proportionate share of the total. Action on said discussion was tabled until more information could be received from other districts, and Grossman would have an opportunity to approach the office manager of the ASC.

Grossman reported that Farley, Miller, Frieze and Worf each received part of the green stipagrass seed which the district purchased.

Grossman reported on field work, and stated that work was being done at the Bender, Boyd, Calvin and Pugh farms, and that work still remained to be done this Fall if possible at the Kowis, Fahrenbruck, Brown, Crosby and Adams farms.

The Board discussed purchase of flagged stakes to be used by the S.C.S personnel for staking ditches, contours and the like. Redeen moved that the district purchase 1000 flagged stakes at a cost of \$10.25, plus \$2.39 parcel post. Motion was seconded and carried.

Grossman presented film strip on discussion of soil bank and how it can be applied to individual farms.

There appearing no further business to come before the Board at this time the meeting adjourned.
